Thank you for your assistance in setting up the site visit by the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR) to Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune. The purpose of this trip is to supplement information gathered on the previous site visit for the health assessment of Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune.

As discussed in our telephone conversation, I scheduled the trip during the week of October 26-30, 1992. A site visit typically includes a tour of each NPL site, meetings with installation activity personnel, and a review of documents in the administrative record for the NPL site. An inbriefing and/or exit briefing with appropriate installation officials can be done, if needed. I will leave the itinerary scheduling to your discretion.
